**TIME:** Doors open 6 a.m. Patients seen on **first-come, first-served basis**, so please arrive early.

**WHO:** **Adults and children** of all ages who are uninsured, underinsured or otherwise unable to visit a dental office and do not have a medically-compromising condition that prohibits receiving care are welcome. Children under age 18 must be accompanied by parent or guardian.

**CARE:** Cleanings, fillings, extractions, limited treatment partial dentures and some root canal therapy will be offered. **All work is provided for free** by dental professionals and community volunteers donating their time and skills.

**NOTE:** Photo identification, social security number or other personal identification or documentation is **NOT** required. **Interpreters** will be available to assist patients.

*Please **do NOT wait** for the Rhode Island Mission of Mercy to seek care  
for severe dental pain, as this could signal a serious condition.*
